several Ohio Department of Health surveyors as they began their annual 4 day inspection. This was followed by our Annual Business meeting on February 16th where reports were made related to the past year's performance. Following are some highlights:

With thankful hearts we report that our 3rd annual survey in a row ended with zero deficiencies! During their annual review the ODH surveyors were very complimentary and encouraging towards us as we strive to provide quality care and services in a Christian atmosphere to those we are called to serve (our mission). Regulatory surveys greatly impact healthcare provider star ratings as reported on Medicare.gov, so these excellent results will help us maintain the highest rating possible at 5 stars.

The Lord provided many blessings in 2015. We were very thankful that generous donations, high occupancy rates, dedicated staff and volunteers, and many other contributing factors helped make it possible to end the year on a positive financial note. We received final occupancy approval for our Chapel & Therapy Expansion Project in September and now our residents and community are reaping rewards from years of planning and labor. In the Nursing Home we welcomed 77 new residents, discharged 60 residents, and had 20 residents pass away. Our Assisted Living/Rest Home and Apartments ended the year full, with a waiting list.

It was special to be reminded at our annual meeting of the dedication service held at Apostolic Christian Home 40 years ago. Following is an excerpt: "Now we dedicate this Home for the purpose that God intended. We want God's name to be first and let us all do our part that the Lord can act and do in and through us that which will bring honor, praise and glory to His name." 
